Thank you for your letter dated 14 December expressing your ethical concerns.

The following is an extract from British Airways World Cargo Rules as shown in the October 2004 edition of TACT (The Air Cargo Tariff) – BA's official tariff that sets out the rules for carriage.

Section 2.3.3 - Restrictions in Acceptance

1.....".in general, primates and wild caught birds and any live animals that are for use in any laboratory or for experimentation or exploitation, will not be accepted for carriage....."

We trust this clarifies British Airways World Cargo's position on this subject.
